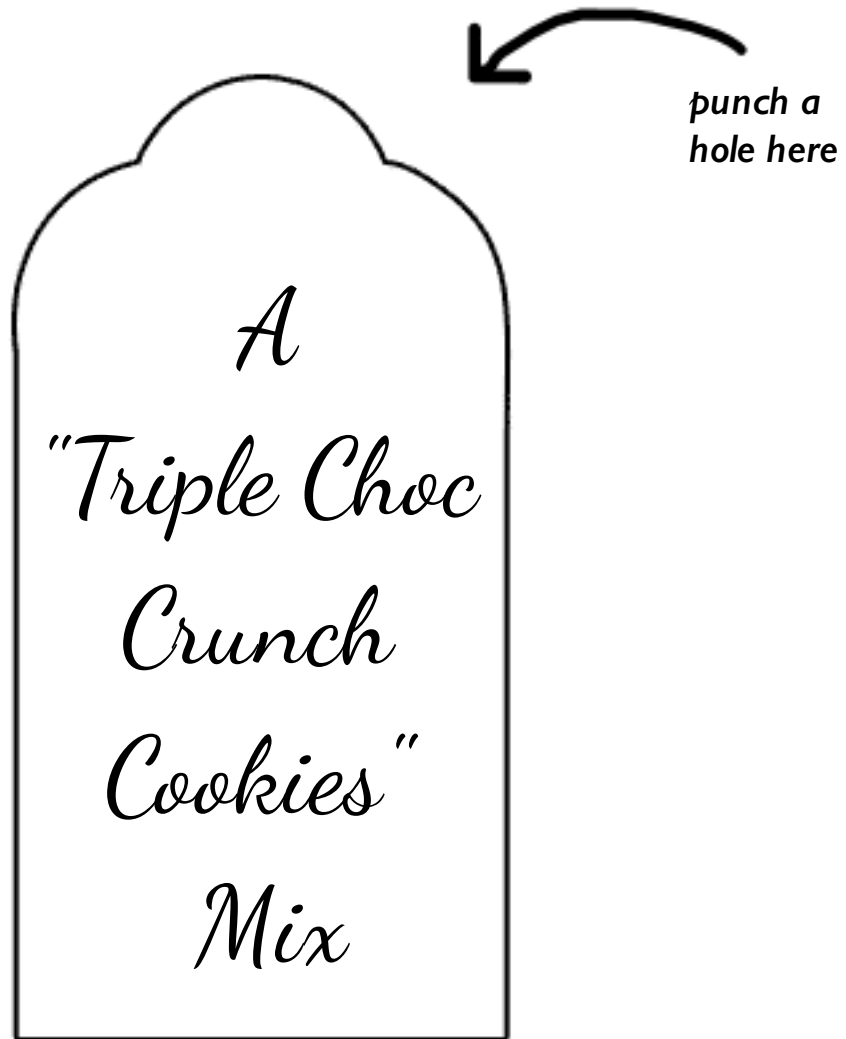


Here's a freeeeeeeby for you!

Instructions:

You can either print it on plain white paper or add a little extra flavor by using a darling scrapbooking paper. I'd recommend a thicker paper, though, so your tag won't be sloppy.

Print the first page, then reload your printer with the same piece of paper, but upside down, and print the second page.

Ingredients

*flour, backing soda, salt,
cornflakes, white and brown
sugar, regular, white and dark
chocolate chips, oats.*

Instructions

*Preheat the oven to 350 degree
Fahrenheit. Add 1 egg and 1/3
cup of butter to the cookie mix
and stir untill evently combined.
Make little balls (0,8 inches in
diameter), places them on a
baking sheet lined with
parchment paper and press
them slightly flat. Bake them
for 12 minutes. And decorate
them if you feel like it!*
